NEPHROLOGY

The Division of Nephrology at Children's Hospital Boston is currently the largest pediatric nephrology service in the United States. It provides specialized services to infants, children and adolescents with both congenital and acquired kidney disease. The division has special expertise in the care of infants and very young children with renal failure and patients with complex urinary tract abnormalities who require dialysis and transplant services. The division is also able to provide general renal consultation on any childhood kidney problems.

CLINICAL PROGRAMS:

General Renal Program

Provides initial consultation and ongoing coordinated treatment of children with any abnormal kidney conditions, with fluid and electrolyte disturbances, or kidney associated metabolic abnormalities.

End-Stage Renal Disease Program

Provides an expert team of physicians, surgeons, nurses, nutritionists and social workers with experience in all aspects of chronic kidney diseases, including dialysis and kidney transplant in children. The team cooperatively plans therapy to preserve growth and development, provides guidance on educational, behavioral and financial issues, and assists in arranging home support and visiting nursing services for children with renal failure.

Hypertension Program

Provides comprehensive evaluation and management of children and adolescents with hypertension. The clinic is held on the second and fourth Tuesday of every month on Fegan 5 at Children's Hospital Boston. Patients are seen by pediatric nephrologist Michael A. Ferguson, MD.
