The Division of Critical Care Medicine is committed to excellence in clinical care, education and research in the field of pediatric critical care.

The Medical-Surgical Intensive Care Unit provides all critical care services for the programs in:

The Division of Critical Care Medicine houses one of the highest volume pediatric intensive care units in the United States. The Division of Critical Care Medicine has a new, state-of-the-art 30-bed pediatric Medical-Surgical Intensive Care Unit. Furthermore, there are consistent excellent outcomes with more than 2,000 admissions annually and a survival rate of 98% , made achievable through a closed-unit intensivist-attending model and in-house attending coverage.

Education

The Division of Critical Care Medicine considers education to be a major component of its mission. Each month we host several international observers, four residents, and on average one medical student to the Division. Our faculty and fellows educate these trainees through various methods ranging from bedside teaching to didactic teaching. During the 2008-2009 academic year, the Division hosted twenty-eight international observers from 9 different countries, 52 junior residents, and 6 medical students.

Currently, The Division of Critical Care Medicines faculty includes 2 professors, 5 associate professors, 5 assistant professors, and 8 instructors.
